Life Line Screening Tests Available at Post 194 – According to information provided by the National Stroke Association, cardiovascular disease is the #1 cause of death in the United States of both men and women. This disease is also the leading cause of permanent disability. It was also reported that 4 out of every 5 stroke victims had no apparent warning signs and that 80% of strokes can be prevented if proper action is taken. With this in mind, the American Legion Post 194 has given permission to a company named "Life Line Screening" to use our back hall on Thursday, May 31, to provide 5 different types of ultrasound screenings related to the early detection of cardiovascular disease. Pre-registration is required. To register, call 800-679-5192 and mention Priority Code HSC4623. It is to be noted that these screening tests are not free – There is a fee associated with each screening test. We want to make you aware that these screening tests are not covered by the Medicare program, nor are the costs reimbursable by the Medicare Program. For more information concerning the purpose of these On-Line Screening tests and their associated costs, please stop by the Legion for more details. We have information packets available that help explain the purpose of these screenings.
