#### Chaplain's Message (From David Bradford, Post 194 Chaplain) -

Prayer. Some only talk about praying. Some go through the motions and mouth the words we were taught as children. Some daydream and wonder when this person will ever be quiet; after all, we need to get home to dinner and the game. Yet when a crisis occurs, the first thing that comes to mind is to ask for God's help. So why do we or should we bother to pray? My answer has always come in the form of questions. Do you believe that you are a child of God? Do like to talk with your children? Well, God loves to hear from his children; to hear about their challenges; to hear of their hopes and dreams. And like most parents, He loves to know that we honor, love, and respect Him. When the person praying is truly invested in that conversation, that is essentially prayer.

Real prayer is a very open and honest conversation with God. Like a child who still lacks the ability or desire to "spin" a story, we gradually become attuned to our parent's voice and hear the love being reflected to us. And yet, some say that God doesn't answer. Maybe it is because we haven't learned the sound of His voice. Or, maybe it is because we expect our answer to be on our time and our terms, rather than on God's time and God's terms.
