Important Notice to All Post 194 Regular Members - Legion Membership Dues Increase Effective **January 1, 2016.** At this year's National American Legion Convention held in the late summer of 2015 in Baltimore, MD, a motion was passed to increase by \$5.00 the price of the yearly membership dues for belonging to the American Legion. The effective date of this \$5.00 increase in annual membership dues will be January 1, 2016. All American Legion Post 194 "Regular Members" are hereby notified that if you submit your 2016 renewal dues after December 31, 2015 your cost for membership renewal will be \$30.00 - instead of the \$25.00 if you pay your dues before December 31, 2015. Note – This increase in membership dues does not pertain to the American Legion Auxiliary Members or the SAL Members. This \$5.00 increase (effective January 1, 2016) has been mandated by the American Legion National Headquarters in Indianapolis, IN.


