Note - All proceeds from the SAL shrimp dinners are used to support the many programs of the SAL Squadron 194. No Shrimp Dinners will be offered during the Month of December due to the many holiday events happening here at the Post Home. The Shrimp Dinners will resume on Sundays in January 2012.

Support for Our Troops Serving Overseas – With the Holiday Season approaching soon, Post 194 will be collecting various items that we will send to our Troops serving in Iraq and Afghanistan. We are collecting various types of personal hygiene items (tooth paste, tooth brushes, shampoo, deodorant, etc.), various types of snack items that won’t melt (cookies, gum, hard candy, chips, etc.), other types of personal items (Q-tips, Dr. Scholl’s insole pads, visine, eye drops, chapstick, etc.), magazines, books, DVDs & CDs, and International Phone Cards. Note – If you want to write a short letter thanking the troops for serving our country, we will make sure your letters get delivered to the troops.
